## Honoring Charles Dean (Chuck) Porter

Thanks for all you did for Our Country

TO:

Lee Jones, John Keeney, Kalen Houston, & Dan Payne, and to others of my love for flying and helping young men with a burning desire to learn to fly, for it was my ambition before starting to school. I could only dream it would become a reality and provide a career that was a childhood dream.

Because I pursued my wish, I was fortunate enough to be accepted for flight training in the U.S. Air force beginning in 1952. That love has continued until 2006.

I built two homebuilt biplanes that provided many hours of joy, and more so the flying of the same and others that were available.

I mentored several teenagers during my flying days that I taught to fly and the necessity for SAFETY at the foremost, and at little or no cost to them.

I was fortunate to have flown the T-6 Texan in primary training, moving on to the next phase in the T-33A jet trainer, then on to Nellis Air force Base in the F-86F Saber Jet until the end of the Korean War. Back in the States (Mojave Desert) flying the F-86H and the F-100C Super Saber, (the first fighter to exceed supersonic speed in straight and level flight). I enjoyed every second of every flight even though I experienced engine out landings on squadron test flights. To all of the instructors I flew with, what can I do but say thanks to all of you.

I was fortunate to fly for UNITED AIRLINES with the nicest pilots I've ever known.

As I come near to the end of the road (I've been diagnosed with pancreatic cancer, which has no known cure), please don't mourn for me, for I have had the best life I could have lived. Like General Jimmy Doolittle near the end of his life said, "I could never be so lucky again". (General Doolittle was the leader of 25 Air Force B-25 two engine bombers that took off from aircraft carriers to bomb Tokyo at near the end of the US/Japanese portion of World War II.
