²⁶ They came back to Moses and Aaron and the whole Israelite community at Kadesh in the Desert of Paran. There they reported to them and to the whole assembly and showed them the fruit of the land. ²⁷ They gave Moses this account: "We went into the land to which you sent us, and it does flow with milk and honey! Here is its fruit. ²⁸ But the people who live there are powerful, and the cities are fortified and very large. We even saw descendants of Anak there. ²⁹ The Amalekites live in the Negev; the Hittites, Jebusites and Amorites live in the hill country; and the Canaanites live near the sea and along the Jordan." ³⁰ Then Caleb silenced the people before Moses and said, "We should go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly do it." ³¹ But the men who had gone up with him said, "We can't attack those people; they are stronger than we are." ³² And they spread among the Israelites a bad report about the land they had explored. They said, "The land we explored devours those living in it. All the people we saw there are of great size. ³³ We saw the Nephilim there (the descendants of Anak come from the Nephilim). We seemed like grasshoppers in our own eyes, and we looked the same to them."

MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

Our UMW will be preparing school kits for UMCOR. The kits will be taken to Annual Meeting at Lake Junaluska in September. Please make this one of your priority projects for the year. They will be sent on to Baldwin, LA to the UMCOR Depot. The kit is designed for a variety of ages. Please be sure the kits contain only the items requested and nothing more. Do not include any personal notes, money or additional materials. These things must be painstakingly removed and will impede the progress of the shipment. (School Supplies are on SALE at Wal-Mart and other discount stores)

Kit Items

- 1 pair blunt scissors (rounded tip)
- 2 pads (or loose leaf) of 8 ½ x 11 ruled paper
- 1 30-centimeter ruler
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener
- 6 unsharpened pencils with erasers
- 1 eraser, 2 ½"
- 12 sheets construction paper (varied colors)
- 1 box of 24 crayons (only 24)

If possible, prepare a 14" x 16" (finished size) cloth bag with handles and closure (closure optional, may be done with buttons, snaps or Velcro) if you do not have a cloth bag for the items, please make up the kit and place it in a gallon plastic bag.

The cost is approximately \$1.00 (each kit) for processing and shipping kits around the world, you may send a check written to UMCOR Sager Brown or \$1.00 cash in a separate envelope and tape it to the outside of the kit. Please **do not** put money or check inside kit.
