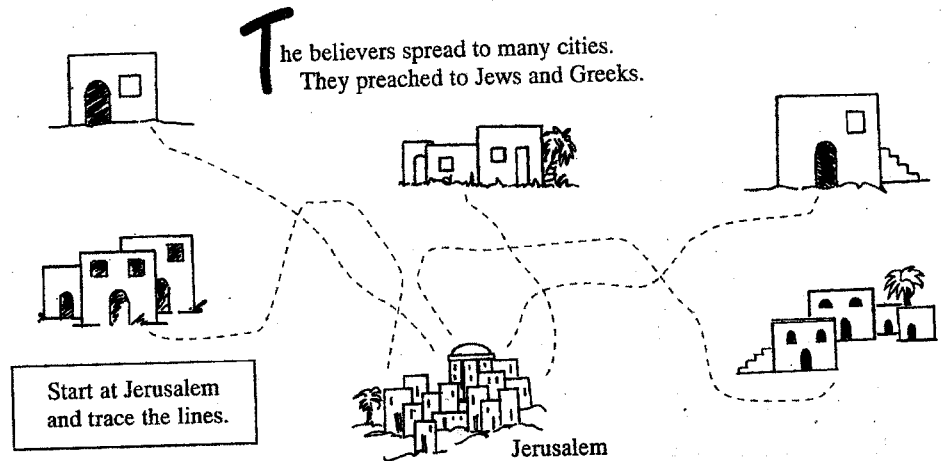

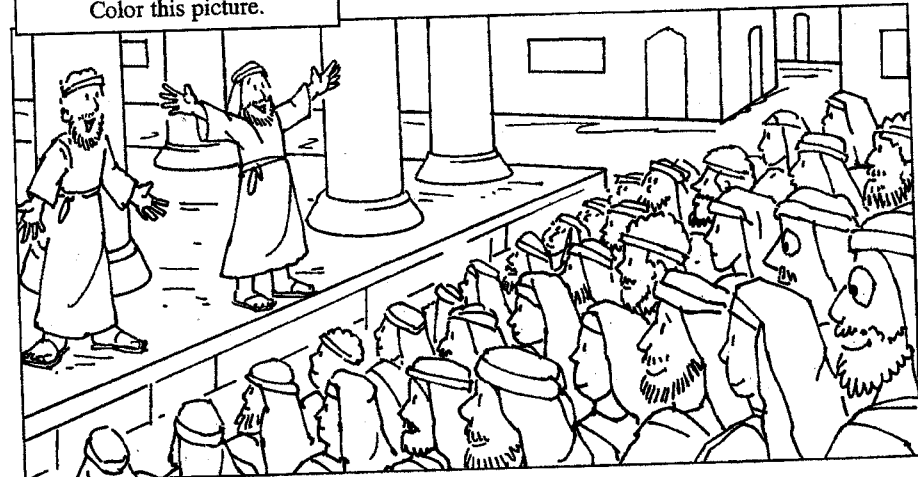
BARNABAS IN ANTIOCH
