Scripture Reading: Joshua 6:1-7 (NIV)

¹Now Jericho was tightly shut up because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. ²Then the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. ³March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. ⁴Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. ⁵When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have all the people give a loud shout, then the wall of the city will collapse and the people will go up, every man straight in. ⁶So Joshua son of Nun called the priests and said to them, "Take up the ark of the covenant of the Lord, and have seven priests carry trumpets in front of it." ⁷And he ordered the people, "Advance! March around the city, with the armed guard going ahead of the ark of the Lord."
