

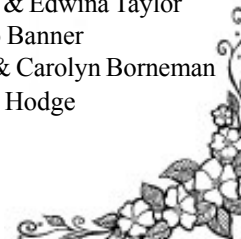

## FREE Cultural Competency Training for Health Care Providers

QSource is sponsoring a project by the Office of Minority Health offering free Cultural Competency Curriculum Modules to physicians, nurses, physicians assistants and other health care officials who provide care to minorities or undeserved populations. Upon completing the nine-module course, physicians and physician assistants can earn 9.0 continuing medical education credits (CMEs) and nurses can earn 10.8 CMEs.

Because practitioners in your congregation may perform missionary work, they are more likely to come into contact with people from various cultural and linguistic backgrounds. The Cultural Competency training will enhance the practitioners' awareness, knowledge and skills in diverse care to better treat patients of various backgrounds.
